TALK IT OVER | LESSON 4

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story, **Jesus Raises Lazarus from the Dead**, with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home early childhood video. Remember that *because we are made in God's image, we will care about people's feelings!*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. Why was Jesus sad in today's Bible story?
He was sad because his friend, Lazarus, had died.
3. What did Jesus do that showed us he was sad like Mary and Martha in the Bible story?
The Bible says that Jesus wept. That mean Jesus cried. When someone cries, that shows us that they might be sad.
4. Can you think a time when you were sad? How did someone show you they cared about your feelings when you felt sad?
When we share that we are sad, people can be with us and help us. Next time you see someone who is sad, you can think of something to do to show them you care about how they feel. Let's think about some things we could do together.
5. What did Melly, Jim, and Gift make today in the Let's Make It! studio?
They made playdough then used it to make different emotions on their emotions mat. The recipe for their playdough and the playdough mat are in the activities section for you to do at home with an adult at home, too!
6. Pray with your child and thank God that he says we are his masterpiece! You might pray something like this: *Dear God, thank you for caring about my feelings. You know when I am happy, scared, sad, or excited, and you still love me no matter what. Help me show other people that I care about their feelings, too, so they can know that I love them. Amen.*
