EARLY CHILDHOOD CRAFT | LESSON 1

THE LAST SUPPER

This week, the kids are learning about the Last Supper and how we should always remember the amazing thing Jesus did for us. To help reinforce this concept, they are going to use the paper bread slices to recreate the Bible story. The hope is that they will use the Bible story bread necklace as a reminder of the Bible story and how much Jesus loves them.



DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Have string or yarn ready in the classroom. The leaders will use this to help the kids turn this craft into a necklace.
2. Print out bread slices.
3. Have bread slices cut before service. Also have each bread slice have one single hole punch through it in the top corner.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Make sure each kid has every sliced bread cutout needed to make the entire Bible story.
2. Allow time for the kids to color each slice. As they color, point out what's happening in the Bible story on whichever slice they are coloring on.
3. When all done coloring, assist the kids in putting their bread slices on their yarn or string. Make sure they are in the correct chronological order of the Bible story.
