MISSION CONTROL PLACEMAT

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print the Mission Control Placemat printable onto 11x17 white cardstock.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Give one placemat to each child and help them write their name on the back.
2. Distribute crayons and encourage the children to color their placemat and do the maze.
3. Remind the children that just like David, we can trust that God will take care of us all the time. Talk about age-appropriate situations where we should trust God to take care of us.
