CREATE-A-ROCKET

This week we are learning about the Bible story of Joshua. In this story, the priests had to trust that the water would stop so they could walk across. This story helps to remind us that God can do more than we could ever imagine. Now, let's use our imagination to create a rocket out of our footprints.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print the Rocket background printable onto white cardstock.
2. Print the Rocket shape template printable onto various colored cardstock and cut out the pieces.

AT THE BEGINNING OF SERVICE*

1. Individually call each child to the paint station where they will remove one shoe.
2. Write the child's name on the back of the Rocket background printable.
3. Paint the bottom of the child's foot and have them step onto the center of the page.
4. Wipe off the bottom of the child's foot with a baby wipe and help them put their shoe back on.

AT CRAFT TIME

5. Distribute the children's completed footprint page, glue and the shapes to each table.
6. Encourage the children to use their imagination and create a rocket on their page using the shapes and their footprint.
7. Read the teaching objective to the children.
8. As each child finishes their rocket, provide markers and invite them to color the rest of the page.

**You can also create a foot shape by tracing the children's shoe onto the page instead of a painted footprint.*
